Please plan on attending a brief congregational meeting after this Sunday's service to elect PNC committee members.

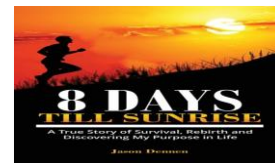
THIS WEEK'S ZIMBABWE TRIVIA & ZMP FUNDRAISING LINK

A former orphan was saved by the HCOC not only once but twice. In 2002, she and her younger sister were found by HCOC founders, Ralph and Roberta Pippitt when she was just a 4th grader. She and her sister would try to go to school but would be sent home because they could not pay the school fees. The Pippitts took them into the HCOC system providing them with food, clothing, medical needs, school fees and school uniforms. In 2008, she got married, but her husband was abusive. She took their child and left her husband. She was searching for a job when she was offered the chance to train and work in the Moringa project. Once again, the HCOC came to her rescue.
