



PROJECT REPORT

Accessing to sufficient, affordable, continuous and clean water is the basic need of human being. Sustainable Development Goal (6.1) calls for universal and equitable access to safe and affordable drinking water. However, most of people living in remote area in Cambodia are in dire need of improved water source for drinking and domestic consumption .Having access to improved water supply can contribute positively to health and poverty alleviation. Recently, with the support from the Water Bender.Sg, the EFC has executed the Water Pump Project for the Needy in three provinces.

2. PROJECT BENEFICIARIES AND TYPE OF WATER WELL

EFC has selected the beneficiaries from three provinces namely Tbong Khmom, Kratie and Steung Treng. There are three big-pumps are installed in Tbong Khmom, one small pump in Kratie and one digging well in Steung Treng province. The different types of water well construction is due to soil layers and source of ground water.

This project allows 87 poor people to access to cleaned water. Previously they had to travel far away to get the water and it was dangerous during the night time. The Table below present the beneficiaries, their address and type of well.
