

Partnership in the Gospel

Earlier this month, Jon had the opportunity to meet for 3 days with leaders from 20+ other likeminded ministries. The Fellowship focused on prayer, sharing stories and opportunities, learning about groups of people that have had little to no access to the Good News, and getting to know each other better. There is a strong sense of a desire to work together



towards a common goal, helping each other along the way as much as possible. Part of that is seeing more and more Eg tins equipped and sent out.

Since living here, we have connected with our local Presbyterian church and are thankful to participate in such a strong and healthy church... They are a part of the largest Protestant denomination in the country, and our EPC denomination back in the US is eager to see her churches connect with these churches ...**Please pray** for wisdom as we consider how this may develop.

Back in Mekelle, our friends sent an exciting report of another training they gave to Church leaders and clergy in training in a rural area south of Mekelle. ... Please pray for another training in another town to the North for 50 moreThings are still highly unstable in the Tigray region, the whole country, and even the entire larger region. **Please pray** for financial provision for many more trainings.

Kristi has really been enjoying getting to know her and learning about many aspects of the culture here.
