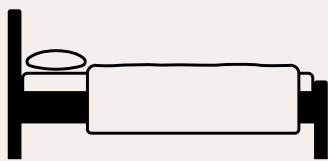




# Nevada County

## 2022 Homeless System Performance

The homeless response system in Nevada County served **669 People** and **556 Households** experienced homelessness from 10/1/2021 - 9/30/2022



People experiencing homelessness spent an average of **156 days** homeless

**23%** of all people served exited homelessness to a permanent housing destination

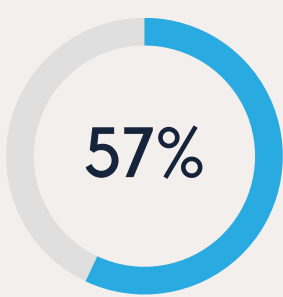


## What is the Homeless Respose System in Nevada County?

The homeless respose system is the network of providers collaborating to quickly and efficiently move people and households out of homelessness and into housing. These providers includes nonprofit organizations, housing authorities, local and federal government agencies, faith-based organizations, the VA, shelter providers, and other homeless coalitions.

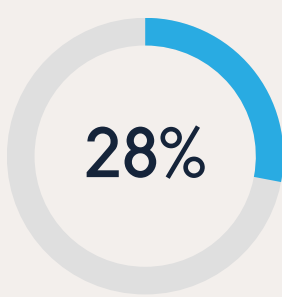


### First Time Homeless



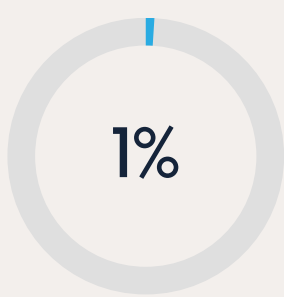
315 households experienced homelessness for the first time

### Continuously Homeless



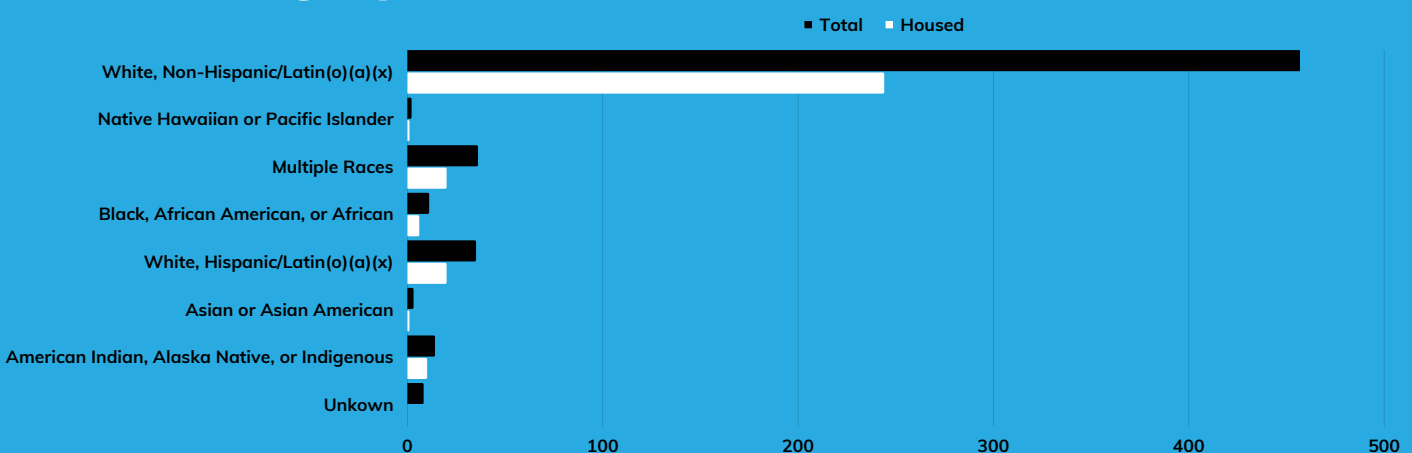
158 households remained homeless from the previous reporting period
